SCHOOL FEES PAYMENT TERMS

1. Students enrolling for the first time at Mnara School Nairobi, must pay a one-time non-refundable admission fee of Ksh 5,000.
2. A continuous sibling discount of 5% is applicable on Tuition Fees for the Second child, 7% for the Third child, and 10% for the Fourth child and subsequent children.
3. Full fees are payable on or before the first day of the school term. The school reserves the right to suspend its services for students with pending fees by the end of the week of the term.
4. An early payment discount of 10% applies to annual tuition fees paid in full on or before the first day of the term.
5. The School will charge a monthly fee of 3% on the outstanding fee balance after the end of the first month of opening the school.
6. The School reserves the right to review the tuition fees annually at 1.5%.
7. If full-term fees are not cleared after the first day of the term, the student will not be allowed to attend classes, transport services, or participate in other school activities.
8. Any new request for transport and lunch, and withdrawal from the same services, should be made in writing to the school.
9. Any payment made will first be allocated to tuition fees.
10. IGCSE examination Fees, Checkpoint Assessment fees, school activities, field trips, and other optional trips for which the parents will be invoiced separately. The information on the stated areas will be shared with parents within a reasonable time. These payments shall be paid before or by the due date communicated.
11. All payments must be made by direct bank deposit, transfer, or M-Pesa. Parents must provide the Accounts Office (finance@mnara.co.ke) with a hard or electronic copy of the proof of payment showing the family file number to avoid delay in crediting their accounts.
12. Any dishonored cheque from the parent will attract a penalty of Ksh 3,000 and affect the parent's credit rating.
13. If a parent wishes to withdraw their child from the School, one term's advance notice of withdrawal must be given in writing, or one term's fees in lieu of notice are payable. School clearance will not be complete until all outstanding dues are fully settled.
14. The School reserves the right to appoint a debt collector if the fees have been in arrears for more than one term.
15. For those withdrawing from the School with an outstanding fee balance, if the school's efforts have not yielded any positive response from the parents, the school will take other measures, including legal resources, to enforce debt collection.
